Class of 2020 Check Writing Campaign

Dear Parents/Guardians:

At the School of Science and Engineering at Townview Magnet Center, our students have worked rigorously over the past few years. As a reward for such excellence and diligence, we would like to celebrate our years of success with a memorable event.

Given that there was an **overwhelming** vote for the Majestic Theater, the fundraising efforts must now be driven by both parents and students. An important factor for the check writing campaign to flourish is a large amount of support. Parents and students are encouraged to donate towards the fundraising efforts for the Majestic Theater graduation venue. Assuming that each family in SEM contributes to the check writing campaign, approximately \$125 would suffice for each family to donate. Passionate families are more than welcome to generously give more than what is suggested to support those families who are financially unable to give as much. If for any reason we fail to meet the required cost, the graduation venue will be set on Ellis Davis Field House by default. All funds raise by that point will be refunded.

The Student Council Class of 2020 will be working in junction with the PTSA in collecting and tracking all funds raised. Before we go on Spring Break, we ask that you join us in our check writing campaign, which will be open for collection by means of cash and check **only** on the following dates:

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All donations are tax-deductible. Receipts will be given at time of donation. Checks are made out to the SEM PTSA, Junior Graduation. All donations, whether it be cash or check, must be in an envelope with the student’s name, parent’s name, and amount of donation. For parents/students unable to come to those times, an alternative option is available. By Monday, March 4th, an online PayPal method will be open for collection. Parents will be able to pay their \$127 (\$2 service fee incorporated) as well as donate however much extra they wish.

Finally, we would like to kindly remind you that the School of Science and Engineering Magnet is not requiring any family to donate or engage in fundraising towards graduation. However, in order for this event to be a success, we entreat you to support us as much as possible. We project to secure all funds for the Majestic Theater by the end of March, but highly encourage everyone to donate at the start of the check writing campaign. We hope that your strong sense of enthusiasm and passion can be conveyed by your participation in the check writing campaign.
