UT Southwestern Medical Center High School Internship in Psychiatry and Mental Health 2020 Information Sheet

Internship Summary

Inspiring Careers in Mental Health is a two-week internship organized by the Psychiatry Department at UT Southwestern Medical Center. It is designed to allow high school students who are potentially interested in fields such as psychology, psychiatry, and neurology to observe people in those fields, learn about the breadth of related careers, and learn how mental health careers can positively impact people in the community.

Dates, Times, and Location

The internship is two weeks (weekdays only) from Monday, June 1, 2020 to Friday, June 5, 2020, and from Monday, June 8, 2020 to Friday, June 12, 2020. Each day, participants are expected to arrive by 7:45 AM to begin the day at 8:00 AM. Ending times vary for each day and are listed in the internship schedule, but participants can expect to be done each day between 11:00 AM and 12:00 PM (although some days may end early; refer to the internship schedule for details). Participants will meet each day at the Seay Biomedical Building (2201 Inwood Road, Dallas, TX, 75390). Transportation will be provided from the Seay Building to wherever the participants are expected to be, but transportation will NOT be provided to the Seay Building or back home, so please plan accordingly if you choose to apply.

Applicant Criteria

Applicants for the internship must meet the following criteria:

- They must be entering 10th, 11th, or 12th grade the following year (students entering 9th grade or students who have graduated from 12th grade are ineligible).
- They must be legal residents of the United States, as illegal residents cannot complete the credentialing process for Parkland Hospital that is necessary for internship participation.
- They must complete the internship application and submit it on or before Monday, March 16, 2020.
- If selected to participate, they must complete the credentialing process for Parkland Hospital. Information on this process will be emailed to participants if they are selected for the internship.
